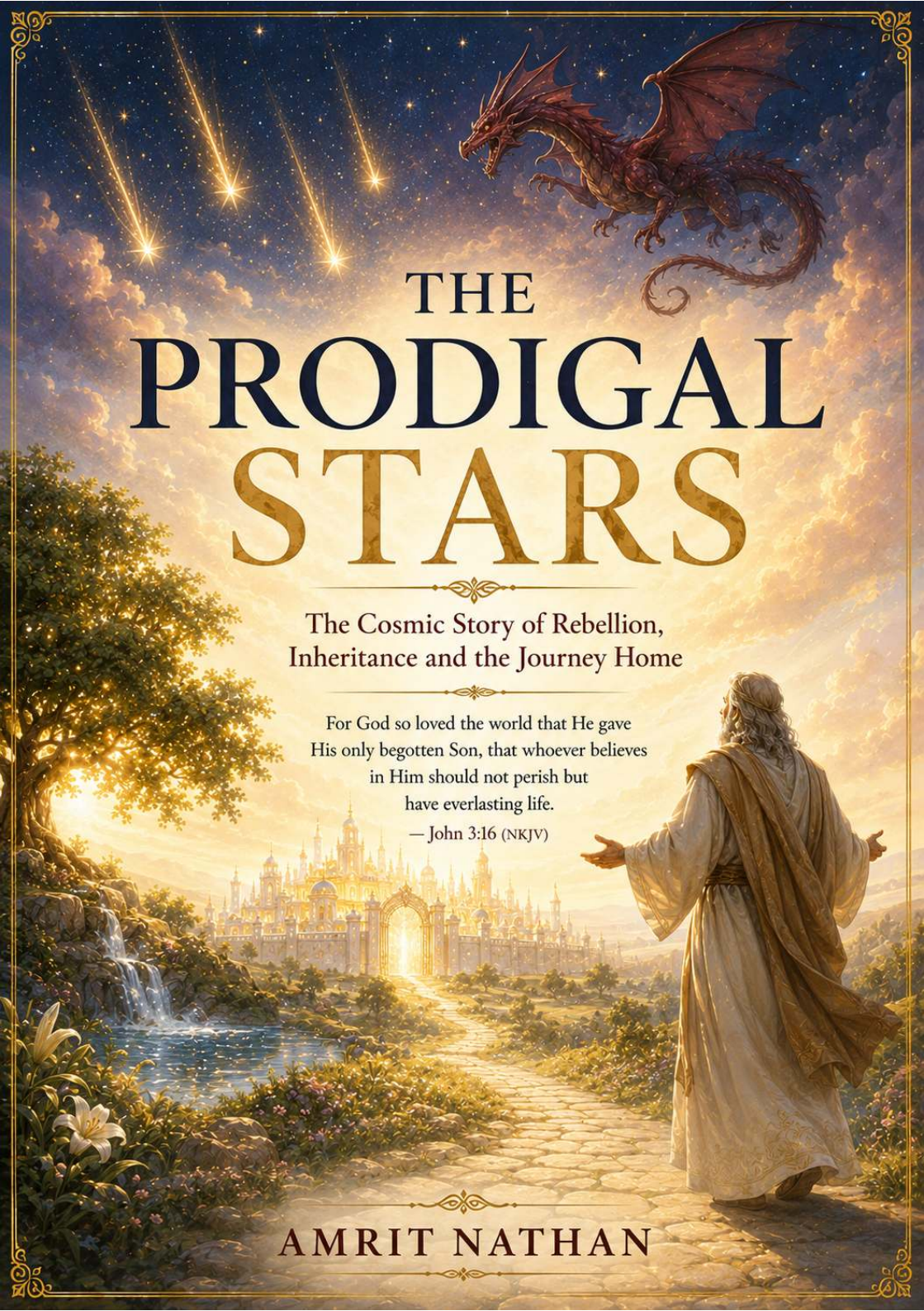




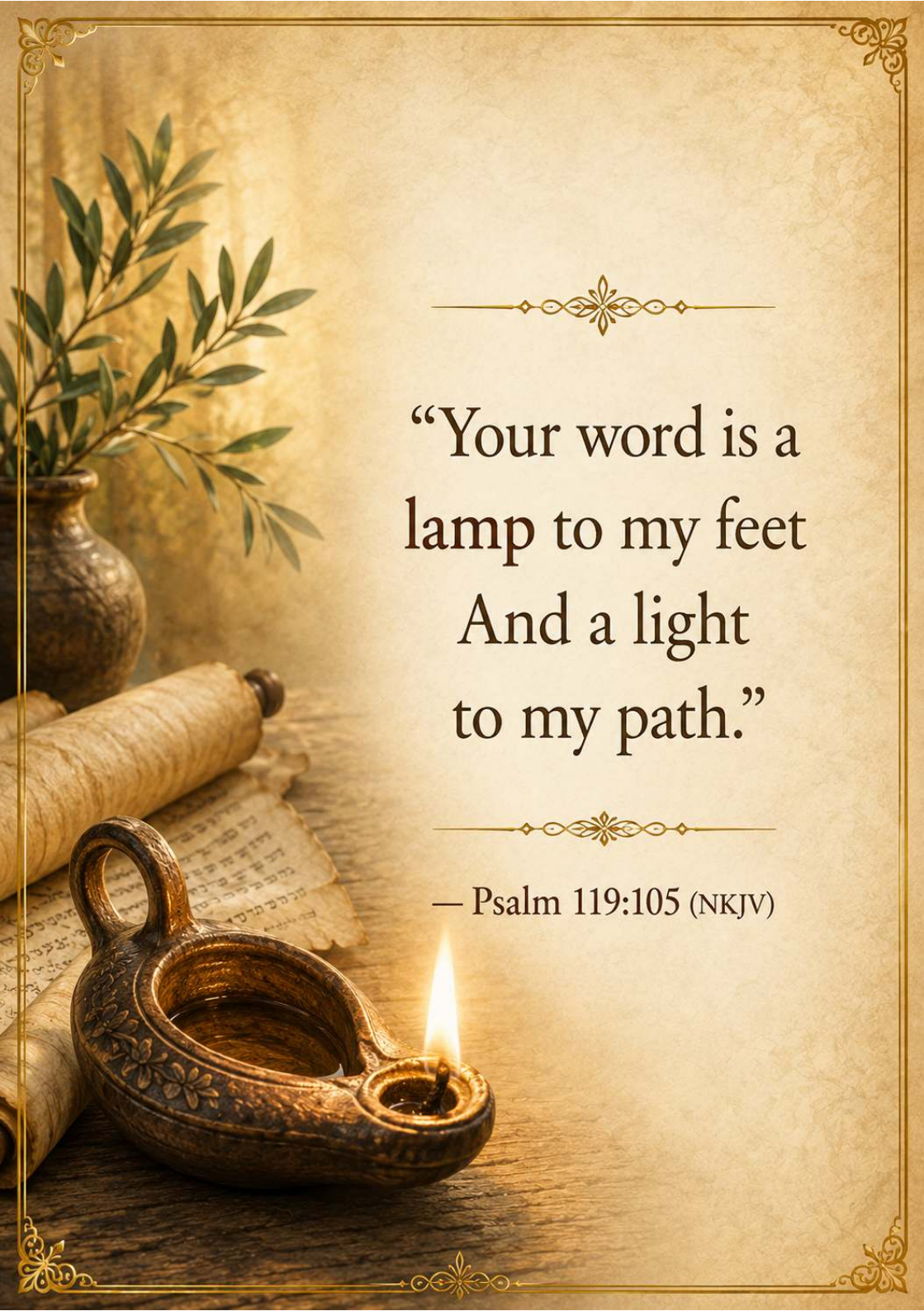

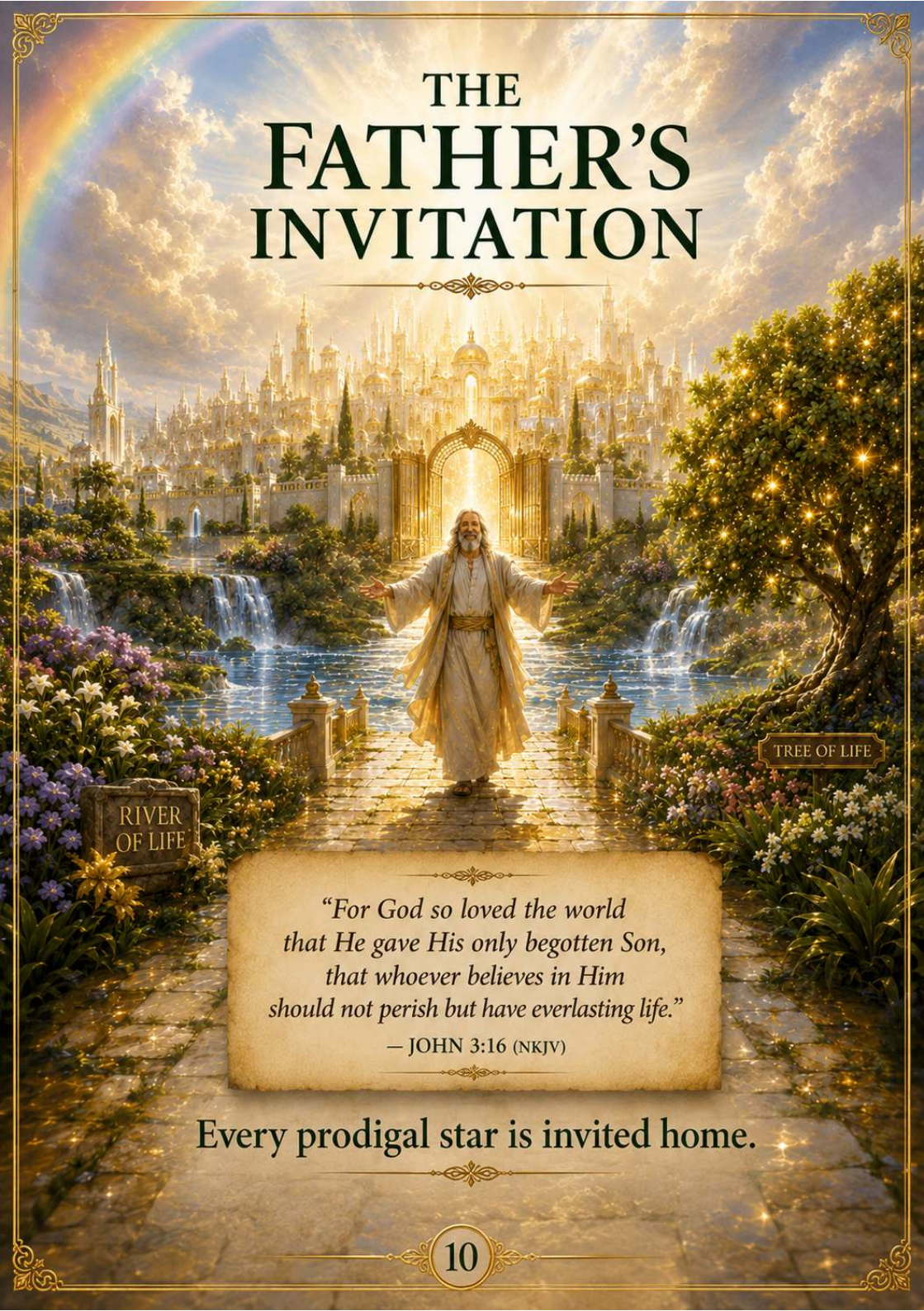

WISE CHOICE

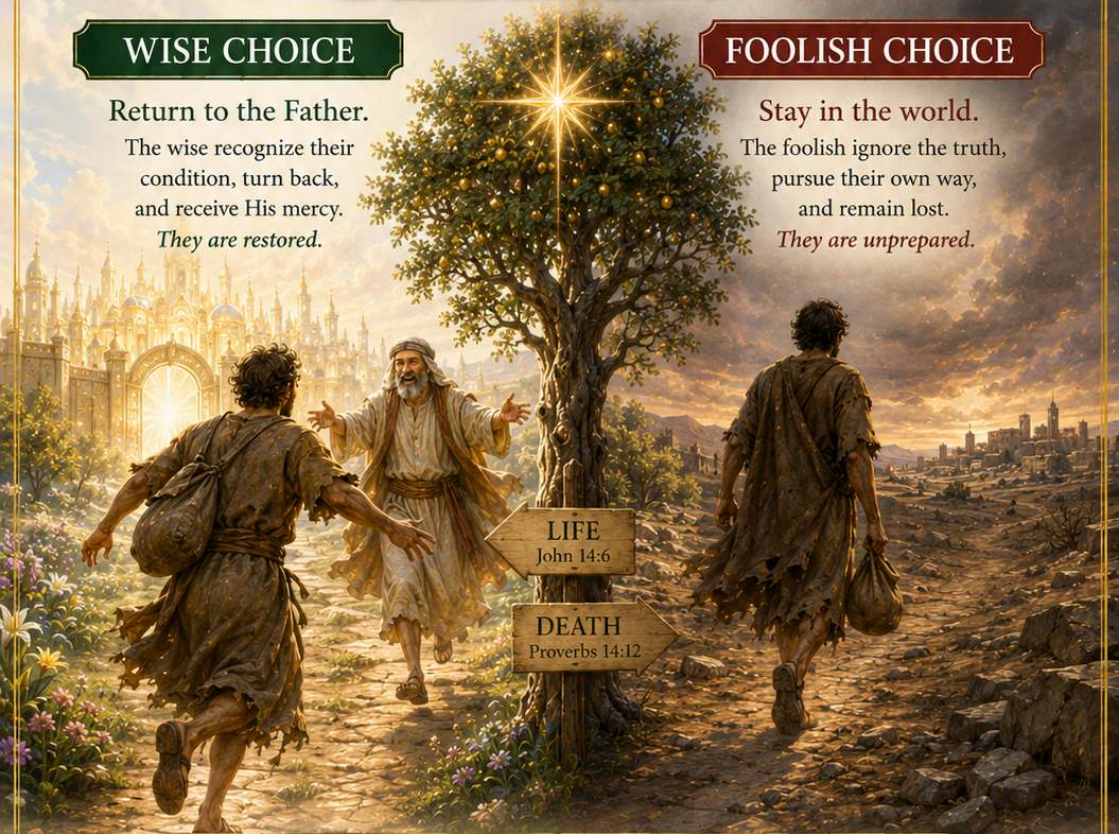
Return to the Father.
