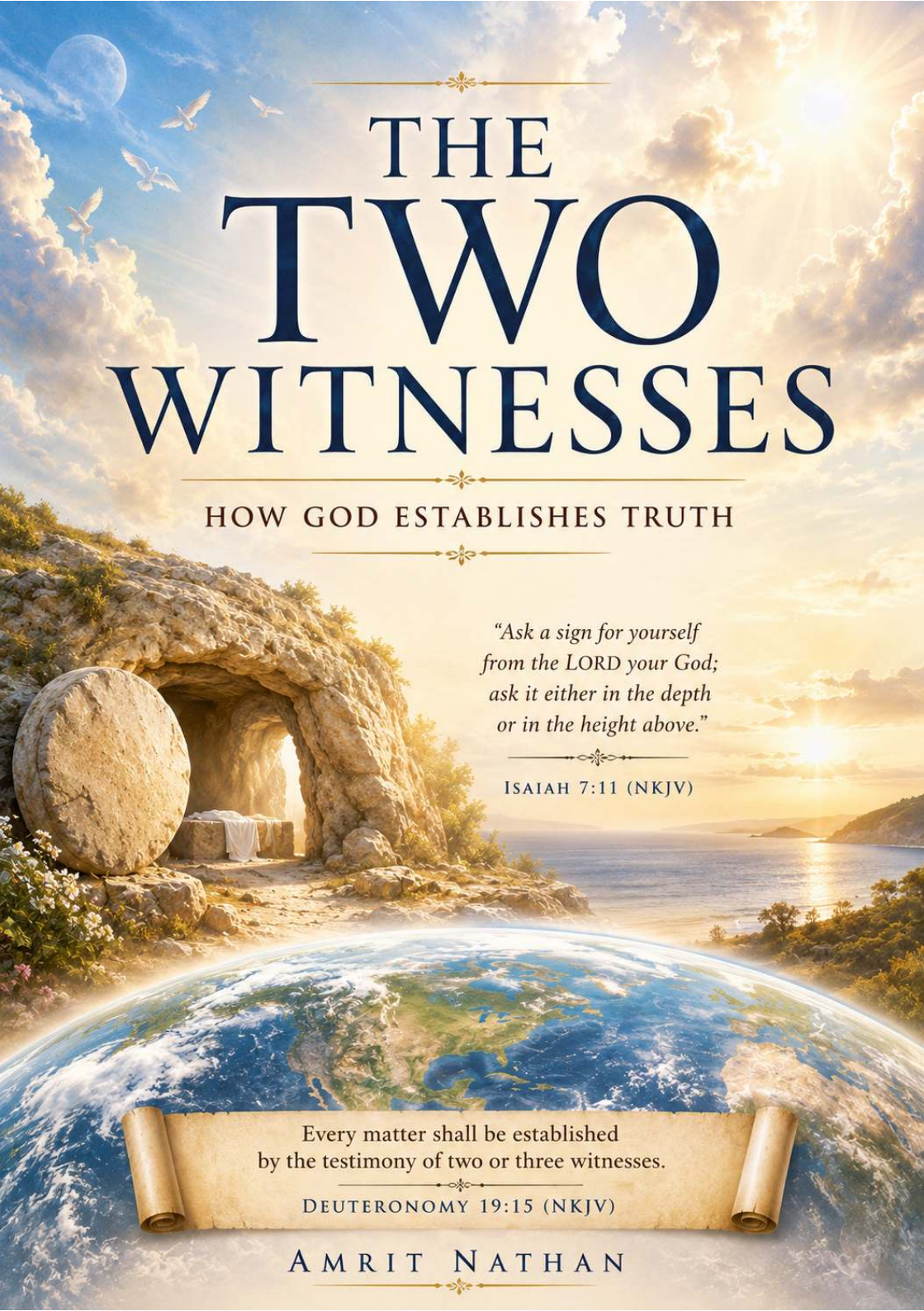

Before God revealed His prophecies,
He first established a principle.

Truth is never intended to stand upon a single testimony.

Throughout Scripture, God repeatedly confirms His word through two witnesses.

This pattern appears in the Law, the Prophets, the Gospels and Revelation.

The same principle prepares us to understand the Sign
that Yahshua gave concerning Himself.



"One witness shall not rise
against a man concerning any

commits; by the mouth of
two or three witnesses the
matter shall be established."

God does not ask us for blind faith.
He establishes truth through faithful witnesses.

THE FIRST WITNESS

THE SIGN UNDER THE EARTH

AS
JONAH
—
SO
YAHSHUA

When the Pharisees asked Yahshua for proof that He was the promised Messiah,
He did not point to His miracles.

Neither did He point to His teachings.

Instead, He gave **one sign**.

He compared Himself with the prophet Jonah.

Just as Jonah remained in the belly of the great fish
for **three days and three nights**,

the Son of Man would remain in the heart of the earth
for the same period.

This was the **first witness**.

It came from **the depth**,
exactly as Isaiah had foretold centuries earlier.



“An evil and adulterous generation
seeks after a sign, and no sign
will be given to it except
the sign of the prophet Jonah.”

“For as Jonah was three days and
three nights in the belly of
the great fish, so will the Son of Man
be three days and three nights in
the heart of the earth.”

The first witness was not a miracle to be watched.
It was a sign to be remembered.

THE SECOND WITNESS

THE SIGN IN HEAVEN

The Pharisees were not satisfied
with a sign from beneath the earth.
They returned and asked Yahshua for
a sign from heaven.

Instead of giving a different sign,
Yahshua repeated the very same answer.
The sign of Jonah would remain **His only sign.**

The first witness would appear beneath the earth.

The second would appear in the **heavens.**

Together they would establish the testimony of the Messiah.

Isaiah had already declared

Yahshua revealed both.
The first has already spoken.
The second still awaits its appointed time.

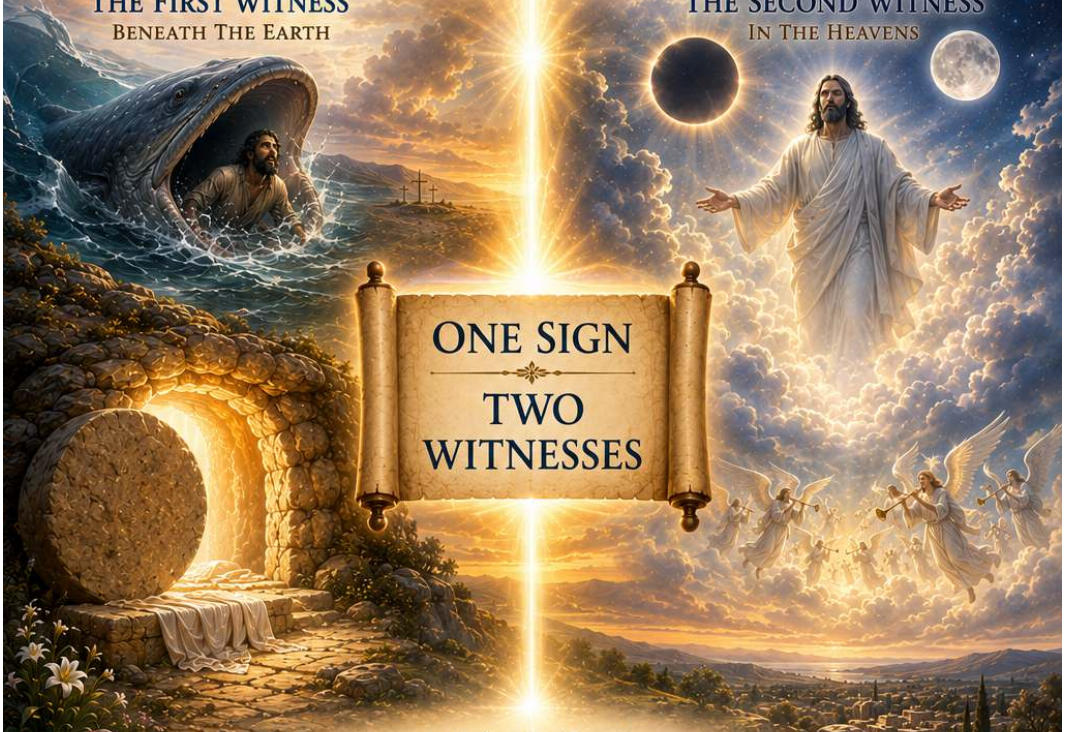

Centuries before the Messiah came,
Isaiah declared that God's sign could come
from the depth
or
from the height above.

Yahshua later revealed that both would testify concerning Him.

The first witness appeared beneath the earth.

The second belongs to the **heavens**.

Together they establish the Messiah's testimony,
just as every matter is established by two witnesses.

THE MEN OF NINEVEH AND THE QUEEN OF THE SOUTH

THEY SHALL RISE IN JUDGMENT

They heard the warning,
believed God's word,
and repented.

THE QUEEN OF THE SOUTH

She travelled great distance
to seek and confirm
Solomon's wisdom.

1 KINGS 10:1-13

After giving the Sign of Jonah,

Yahshua immediately called two historical witnesses.

The men of Nineveh believed God's warning through Jonah and repented.

The Queen of the South undertook a long and difficult journey
to verify Solomon's wisdom for herself.

Neither belonged to Israel.

Yet both responded in faith to the light they had received.

Yahshua declared that these Gentile witnesses would one day
stand in judgment against those who reject the Sign of the Messiah.

If they believed God's testimony under far more difficult circumstances,
what excuse remains for those who refuse to believe the Sign that
God has now provided?

a long, uncertain
journey across

Faith acts upon the testimony God has already given.
Unbelief remains without excuse.

THE TWO WITNESSES OF REVELATION

GOD'S FINAL PUBLIC TESTIMONY

From the beginning, God has established His truth through two faithful witnesses. The pattern reaches its final expression in the Two Witnesses of Revelation.

LUKE 9:1-6

THE TWELVE EMPOWERED

Yahshua empowered the Twelve with the Holy Spirit and sent them ahead to prepare the people for His coming.

John the Baptist prepared the way for Yahshua. Now Yahshua sent the Twelve to prepare His way.

EMPOWERED BY THE HOLY SPIRIT



The early pattern is consistent:

God sends His witnesses in **PAIRS** to prepare the way, to testify, and to invite people to respond.

The final generation will see this pattern **FULFILLED**.

LUKE 10:1-12

THE SEVENTY (TWO BY TWO)

Yahshua sent seventy others ahead of Him in pairs to every city and place where He was about to go.

They went as His representatives but were not yet empowered with the Holy Spirit.

NOT EMPOWERED

REVELATION 7:4-8

THE 144,000 – SEALED FOR THE TESTIMONY

144,000 sealed from every tribe of Israel.

Sealed for protection and purpose.

A people prepared, faithful, and set apart.

144,000 standing with the Lamb on Mount Zion.

Redeemed and ready to testify.

THE TWO WITNESSES – EMPOWERED FOR THE FINAL THRUST

- Clothed in sackcloth
- Two olive trees
- Two lampstands
- Empowered to prophesy 1,260 days
- Testify with God-given power and authority

"And I will give power to My two witnesses, and they will prophesy one thousand two hundred and sixty days, clothed in sackcloth."

— Revelation 11:3

"These are the two olive trees and the two lampstands standing before the God of the earth."

appears.

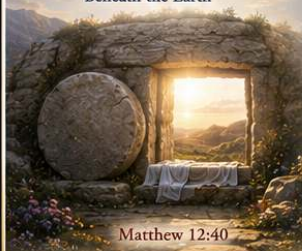


EVERY GENERATION RECEIVES GOD'S WITNESS.

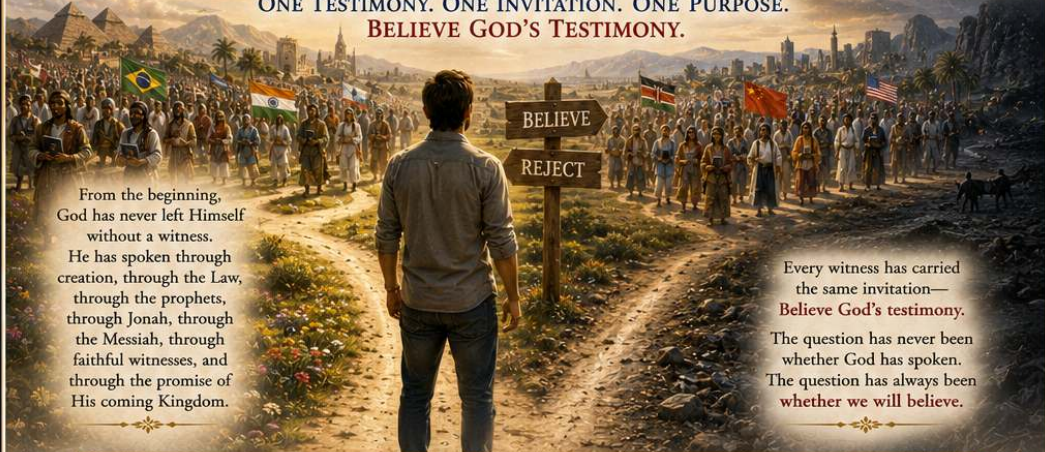

THE FOOLISH VIRGINS

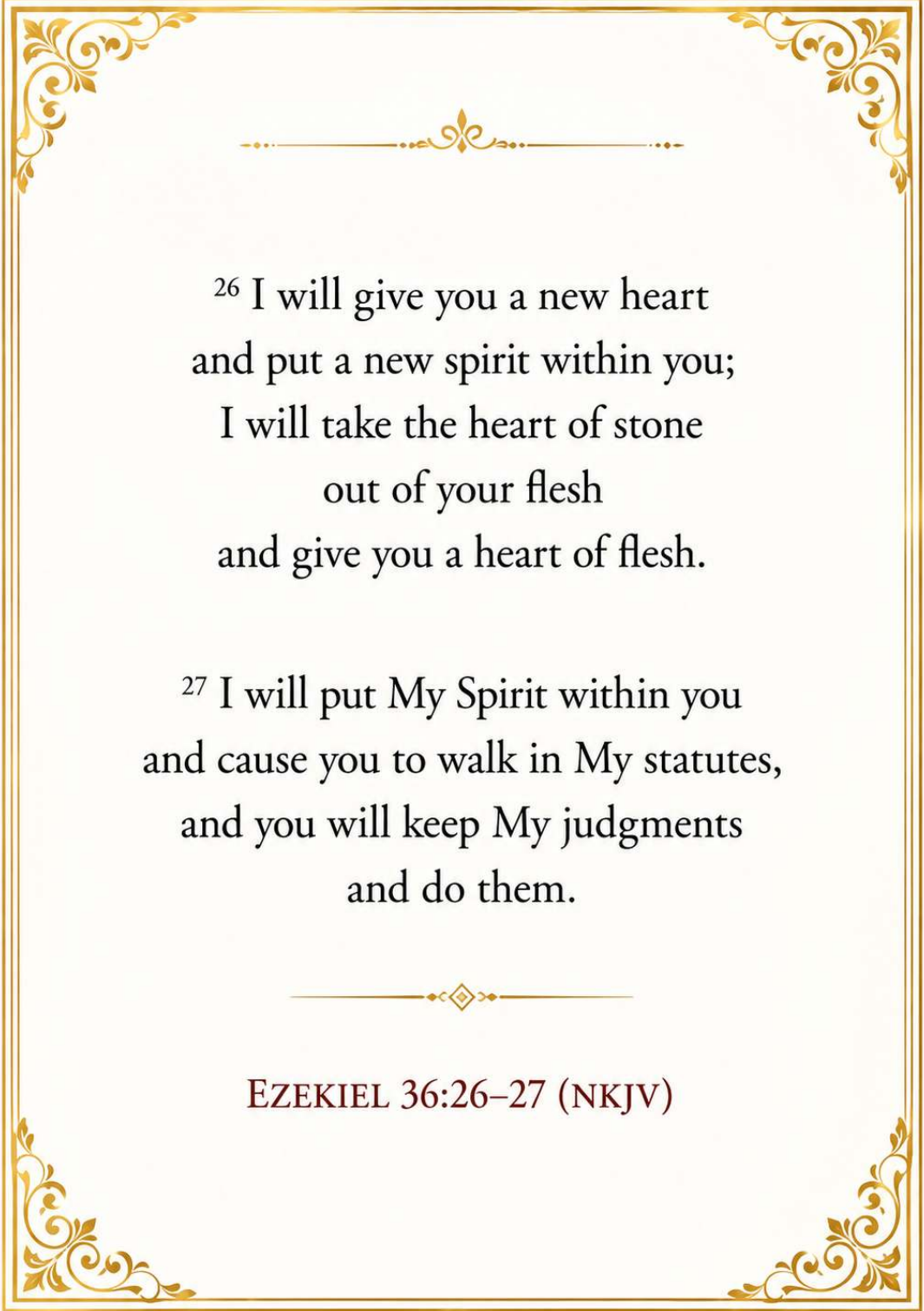
- ✦ Lamps go out
